But in the quiet Township of Teaneck New Jersey, a suburb of New York City, 10-year-old Mary O'Shea and her three schoolmates are consumed with the imminent arrival of The Beatles at Shea Stadium. Mary leads her lively band of friends in forming a fan club, intent on inviting the British band to stay in their homes and, in return, hopefully receiving a personal invitation to the concert. But events, both past and present, threaten to

burst their youthful bubble. *The Beatle Club* is the story of a nostalgic and timeless memory full of endearing humor and love of friendship and family.

#### **Providence Players of Fairfax is:**

### **About the Director: Michael Donahue**

Michael Donahue (Director) has been actively directing and acting with PPF since 2009. An award-winning director, Michael co-directed the PPF May 2021 outdoor play *The Parking Lot* with Jayne Victor and PPF's October 2020 outdoor production of *Lone Star*. On the PPF main stage he has directed *August: Osage County*, *Front Page, Calendar Girls* and *House of Blue Leaves*. Michael has an MFA in Theater Directing and was Artistic Director for Playhouse on the Square's Professional Theatre for Youth in Memphis, TN and Associate Artistic Director for HITT Productions.

#### From the Director, Michael Donahue

The play reminds me of the history of why stories are the hub of clans, tribes, villages, and families. I feel when the storyteller creates a tangible understanding of the mystery of life and brings joy, empathy, and moral dilemmas to the audiences we can all relate because those things are the fabric of us all.

A social gathering to pick up scripts is scheduled for the evening of Monday, August 23. Unless indicated otherwise, all other rehearsals will happen at the James Lee Community Center. Rehearsals will be held in the evenings roughly from 6:30/6:45pm to 9:45pm and on Saturdays and Sundays as indicated.

Please come to auditions prepared to list any availability conflicts with rehearsal or the performance schedule. Space is provided on the audition form for this purpose.

#### **About the Play**

#### **PLACE**

An older suburban home, in The Township of Teaneck New Jersey.

#### Time

Summer, 1965. A dark time politically in a nation consumed by the Vietnam War, student revolts, the Army's draft lottery and the burning of draft cards. And then, the Beatles came.

#### The O'Shea Family

Notes on character ages: While the ages of characters are described in the script the director may cast outside of those ages if it works for the overall casting.

- MARY O 'SHEA President of the Beatle Club, spunky, bright, ten-year-old girl.
- **GRANNY** Mary and Rory's grandmother, Irish, memory difficulties, seventyeight years old. Sings snippets from an old Irish tune throughout the play and speaks and sings with an Irish accent.
- RORY O 'SHEA Mary's brother, impulsive, rebellious, eighteen years old.
- **PATRICK (DAD) O 'SHEA** Mary and Rory's father, burdened, loving, forty-five years old. Speaks with an Irish accent.

### Beatle Club Members - all ethnicities welcome and encouraged to audition for Karen and Eddie.

- DAVID -African American, sharp, with a know-it-all attitude, twelve-year-old boy.
- KAREN affable, best friend to Mary, ten-year-old girl.

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 EDDIE - a good-looking, goofy boy who just wants to be one of the gang, twelve years old.

#### **Additional Audition Information/Instructions:**

- HOW WE WORK: Most Providence auditions have actors up and down to read multiple times in multiple combinations and scenes. Most actors find this fun. As space allows, you will be able to watch the auditions. You may be asked to go outside with audition partners and work a bit on a scene. We will do our best to get you up multiple times reading for parts you are interested in. You will also be asked to read for other parts you may not be auditioning for. The Providence Players strives to make our productions open to interested and engaged actors & actresses, regardless of their level of experience. We try and make our auditions as relaxing and fun as possible.
- AUDITION PROCESS & SIDES: Auditions will consist of readings from the script. No monologue required. Sides for the audition process will be supplied at auditions.
- **AUDITION FORM**: Please ALSO COMPLETE the attached Providence Audition Form and bring it with you to the audition. Resumes and headshots will be accepted but are not required. We may ask to take a picture of you, but this is for internal use only and will not be shared.
